SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



Any band member that wishes to be eligible for a band scholarship their senior year, please read!

Note: There are two different scholarships

BAND SCHOLARSHIP

Any band member that wants to be eligible for a Band Scholarship their senior year must work a <u>minimum of four (4) shifts each TopDog season, beginning their Freshman year</u>. Shifts may vary from 4 to 6 hours depending on the TopDog supplied schedule and needs.

Summer Season (June 24th through July 4th) Requirements:

- 1. Sign up for a minimum of four (4) shifts;
- 2. Be on time and complete the minimum four (4) shifts; and
- 3. One shift must be scheduled during the busy days of July 3rd through July 4th.

Winter Season (Dec. 20th through January 1st) Requirements:

- 1. Sign up for a minimum of four (4) shifts;
- 2. Be on time and complete the minimum four (4) shifts; and
- 3. One shift must be scheduled during the busy days of December 30th through January 1st.

The final amount of the scholarship will be determined your senior year based on budget availability.

TOPDOG SCHOLARSHIP

Each year TopDog offers scholarships to graduating seniors. One senior from the Crosby High School band, who meets the minimum requirements set forth by TopDog, will be selected by the Band Board to receive a \$250 TopDog scholarship. The winner of the \$250 TopDog scholarship is then eligible to compete against seniors from other TopDog store locations for a chance at an additional \$2,000 scholarship.

Minimum Requirements:

- 1. Sign up for a minimum of forty (40) hours your senior year;
- 2. Be on time and complete the minimum of forty (40) scheduled hours; and
- 3. Show good leadership and work ethics.

The Band Board will choose and submit a qualified senior to TopDog by the deadline provided for the year. The senior will then write and submit an essay, topic to be provided by TopDog, by the deadline provided for the year. Winners of the \$2,000 scholarship, selected by TopDog, will be notified by the deadlines provided.
